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Introduction

In our "scientific" world, we are faced with a deluge of "compelling" scientific data. If you have gone to public school, you will have had more than your share of exposure to some of this data, but often in a somewhat indirect manner. The subtle indoctrination regarding evolution being true, and the Bible's Creation account being false, is really quite overwhelming when you look into that aspect of modern education. And when it comes to the arrival of mankind on Earth, we end up splitting hairs and misinterpreting a lot of information regardless of which perspective, religious or scientific, we are viewing the information from.

From an evolutionary science perspective, nothing really matters, and ultimately there are no rules or guidelines. However, from a Biblical Creation perspective, "man" is the pinnacle of Creation, and if man or animals could interbreed with other kinds it would pervert their kind. The desire for our own kind that is in good physical form is a protection for humanity against selecting a path that will lead to the perversion of the ultimate design of man. So long as men and women always seek women and men that they are attracted to, the world will stay diverse and humans will remain pure and prolific. If this could ever be breached, then humans will have tainted their origins and will no longer be pure and in harmony with the Creator's original design.

There is much about this subject that the world is not prepared to hear and will reject. Some of the myths of old have some basis in truth, and we have been misled into believing that certain crossbred animals never existed. We fail to believe what

ancient writings state and is sometimes witnessed in the fossil record. We continue to embrace the erred evolution view that disregards all things that do not abide by the rules of evolutionism whose mantra is, "Throw out all evidence that does not support the theory". Doing so is dishonest and is a lie. When we fail to properly analyze the presented evidence, we then each have deceived our own selves.

From a Biblical perspective, we were Created unique from other kinds of beings, namely animals. And to violate that is a "sin", which is to say that it is void of the desire of God the Creator. That point is very important for all of us to understand. If a Creator does in fact exist, we are ultimately judging ourselves by our choices, possibly resulting in separating ourselves from this alleged Creator. If you buy into the Creation argument or the evolution argument, you then have made the choice as to what you believe. Did you get that? **You** have made the choice. And here is an important point: It may very well be that neither of these two standard belief sets are correct. This means that it is possible that no matter which choice you make, you might be wrong and ultimately be liable for your error—especially if you misguide others using that error.

As you read on, try to remove all biases and read from a fresh perspective, and then analyze the information that you read and see how it compares to what you may have thought before reading this book. Will the information that you read in this book reconcile with science? Will it reconcile with the Bible? And, will it reconcile with reality? You be the judge as you read on and consider the points presented in this volume of *The Science of God.* It is important to note that in this book when the term "man" is used it is typically referring to what we call "mankind" rather than "man" or "woman".

Conceived in Our Image

The question everybody wants to know or prove is: Are humans "Created", or did we "evolve"? That question has been plaguing mankind for hundreds of years, and more than likely, it has been asked for thousands of years through most of recorded human history. Most people are seeking actual answers to the question rather than the petty arguments and name calling we all too often hear. When we're passionate about our beliefs and are frustrated because we are unable to answer all of the questions we're asked, that's typically when voices are raised and mockery ensues, but all to no resolution to our actual questions. Are you willing to hear other people's thoughts on the matter? Or is your mind closed and it is a settled point of "inarguable fact" in your mind?

Since we are discussing Creation in this book, we must to first make the assumption that a Creator exists and analyze that and then dissect parts of Genesis One to see if it is scientifically viable that a "God" Created mankind, or if Genesis One from "The Bible is nothing more than mere fairytales". "I Think Therefore I Am"

I would like to dive directly into the question of mankind having been Created, but since mankind is allegedly "Created" it quickly brings to the table the question of—Who or what exactly was it that caused mankind to be? However, first we need to understand that there is really no such thing as man-*kind*, but rather, it is simply to be stated as "man", but more on that later. Now, since Creating is an intellectual activity, we must dispose of the "*what*" and focus on the "*who*". Let's say that everything did come from a "big bang" which theoretically started as a point so infinitely small that it would be scientifically undetectable, we still have to ask how it got there. Size is a relative aspect of existence, so it does not matter how big or how infinitely small something is, *it* still is there. So if your position is big bang, then ask yourself: How did

Man - The Higher Creation

Can we prove that God actually exists by exploring the evolution-versus-Creation topic? I do believe that any rational mind can do so, but only if we suspend all judgment and make the assumption that a Creator truly exists and then ponder that Creator from that perspective, rather than assuming that there is no Creator as the starting point to prove that a Creator exists. In doing so you should arrive at the conclusion that the Creator is extremely logical and fair and wants only what is good for the Created creatures. And it is this general Creative nature of the Creator that has been instilled into "man".

The basic subject of this book is the arrival of "man". Man can reason through how a self-Created Creator might have come to be, but how did things get from a self-Created Creator to "man"? How did something come from nothing? We can logically suggest a self-Created Creator because conscious is not made from any substance or thing—it just exists. Preserving Creation for the Long-Term

One of the longest and ongoing debates is the evolution-versus-Creation debate, and as mentioned in a previous section, that debate continues partly due to the misunderstanding of words and definitions. When you study the fossils and remains of the many creatures that have been found, what you find is largely what you see today in nature regarding animal forms, with the exception of obvious extinctions, such as dinosaurs. The layers of rock and dirt that have entombed the various forms have in many ways cleared up questions, but have also caused many new questions. If we found no deviation whatsoever from the skeletal structures in modern creatures, then full-scope evolution itself would be entirely extinct. However, since we do find minor amount of deviation and also find many enormous sized extinct creatures, it does lend somewhat to the idea of full-scope evolution.

The fossils and other remains of creatures from eons past are a true gift for researchers or anyone else who has an inquiring mind. Without this history buried safely beneath our feet, we

Most people are more concerned with proving their point than they are with revealing truth. We commit to our errors with an astonishing level of voracity, unyielding in our quest to show others just how "right" we are. A Seed of an Idea

Seeds make the world go round. Without seeds *nothing* could propagate "after its kind" as is explicitly stated so eloquently in the Bible's Creation text. No one on either side of the debate can argue that very simple fact. All seed material has the instruction-set for the particular "kind" variation. This undeniable fact is clearly stated in the Bible and is true in the evolution theory as well; however, in evolution it has no boundaries of a Biblically stated "kind". Evolution states that anything can morph into what would over millions of years end up being a completely different "kind", and in there is the core-overreach of evolution.

But seeds are more than physical constructs that propagate all living things. Seeds are also laid out in ideas. The basic premise here is that all seeds, whether they are physical seeds that will propagate life, or ideas seeds that will propagate thought, all contain vast amounts of *information*. Guided by the Layers

All around the world there is a great deal of evidence regarding evolution and the limits thereof trapped within the many layers of sediment. We find this evidence in bits and pieces as man traverses the Earth and excavates and builds. As we find these historical treasures, we strive to unearth them to reveal the facts. Then we take those facts and analyze them and present our own analysis as if that analysis is the actual found artifacts, which it is not.

It is a fact that we found something and that its structure matches that of a bird or a man or some other creature, and that's about all we really know about the actual artifacts. Any statements beyond that are pure speculation. The sedimentary layers reveal a great deal about Earth's history, but those layers have been contaminated in our minds by our own inaccurate reading of the actual found data. Final Analysis

In the final analysis of the evolution-versus-Creation debate, we find that there are two levels on each side. Evolution has macro and micro and Creation has six-twenty-four-four-day and long-age. Long age Creation is often improperly used in an attempt to make the Bible reconcile with macro-evolution so that they can hold onto their God and their science. But long-age Creation has absolutely nothing to do with evolution. Could it? Possibly, but it is unlikely. For all of the reasons mentioned in this book, macro-evolution is obviously false. But what about sixtwenty-four-day Creation, is it a possibility? No, it is not a possibility. If we choose to believe in the idea of Creation, then we also have to believe in a Creator who Created it all. And to make the assumption that a Creator who so brilliantly and proudly Created "light" is going to cheat the Creation of light itself to get light to us sooner than it could on its own from so far away by defying the Creation itself, is utterly illogical! And to further believe that the Creator would POOF! creatures into existence defies everything we see in nature and thus is also utterly illogical.
